Brief Description of Sports History, including other sports in which you have been involved as well as the desired football position, if any, you would like to play, including a description of your attributes that would make you a qualified candidate for such desired position:

It is understood that this tryout is sponsored by the New England Storm ("Storm"), a Member Team in the Women's Professional Football League ("WPFL"). The purpose of this tryout is to obtain information regarding your potential participation as a full-contact football player for the Storm or, possibly, for other Member and/or Associate Teams in the WPFL.

In order to participate in the WPFL for the 2004 Season, you must be available to attend training camp and play games as scheduled during August through November 2004. If you are a successful candidate following the tryout, you may be invited to participate in one or more mini-camps sponsored by the Storm or other WPFL Member Teams that will test your football skills, agility, and stamina and may involve full-contact scrimmages with uniforms, helmets, and pads.

If you are a successful candidate following the mini-camp(s), you may be invited to participate in training camp for the Storm or other WPFL Member Team. If you agree to attend training camp for the Storm or other WPFL Member Team, you may be asked to enter into a contractual agreement with the Member Team, supplementing and replacing this agreement, setting forth the terms and conditions under which you may be offered the opportunity to participate as a player for such Member Team.

It is understood and agreed that by signing this agreement you are granting to the Storm, subject to any priority established by prior tryouts with another WPFL Member Team within the last 12 months as set forth above, a right of first refusal to offer you a player position with the Storm before you will be authorized to explore your playing opportunities with other WPFL Member Teams. The priority in favor of the Storm will be subordinate to the rights of any WPFL Member Team for whom you have previously tried out within the last 12 months listed above, unless their rights have been expressly waived or you were not invited to participate in either mini-camp or training camp with such team. If you are not offered the opportunity to participate in either mini-camp or training camp by the Storm, you will be free to contact any other WPFL Member Team and the Storm, upon your written request, will forward the information gained at the tryout to the such WPFL Member Team or Teams as you may designate in your written request.

I understand that if I am offered the opportunity to participate as a player in the WPFL I agree to comply with all of the rules, regulations, and guidelines of the WPFL and of the Member Team that selects me as a team member.

It is further understood, that unless the tryout fee is expressly waived in writing by an authorized representative of the Storm, I must execute this agreement and pay a tryout fee of \$75.00, payable to the New England Storm, LLC prior to participation in any tryout or mini-camp activity.

It is further understood that until I am invited to mini-camp or training camp by the Storm or another WPFL Member Team that I am solely and fully responsible for the cost of any medical or other expense that may be incurred as a result of any injury occurring during the tryouts or mini-camps. I hereby agree to waive, release and hold the Storm and the WPFL, as well as its management agent, WPFL and WPFL Promotions, LLC, harmless against any claim for damages that I may incur as a result of any injury occurring during the tryouts or mini-camps.

I further understand that there are significant risks involved in participation in the full-contact sport of Women's Professional Football. I acknowledge and accept the risk that I may sustain one or more serious injuries during the tryout and the mini-camps. In this regard, I have no knowledge that I suffer from any injury or disability that would preclude me from active participation in the tryouts and the mini-camps covered by this agreement. To my knowledge I am not pregnant.

I have volunteered to participate in a program of progressive physical exercise, and understand that there are inherent risks to the sport of football. I assume the known and unknown risks and am responsible for my actions. I hereby release the New England Storm, (medical team/staff /owner) from any claims, demands and causes of action arising from participation in such program now or in the future. The above statements are true to the best of my knowledge.
